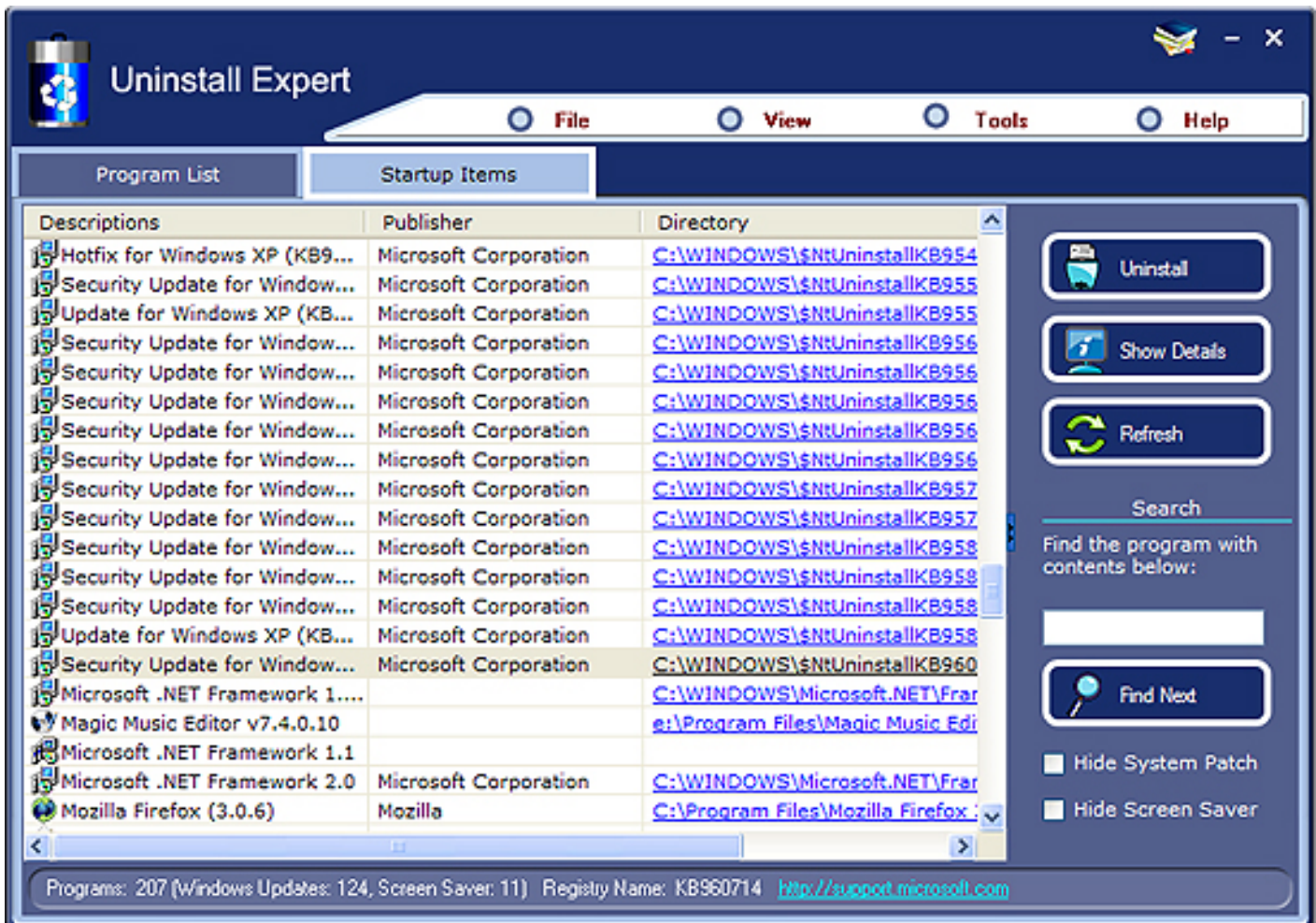

Introduction

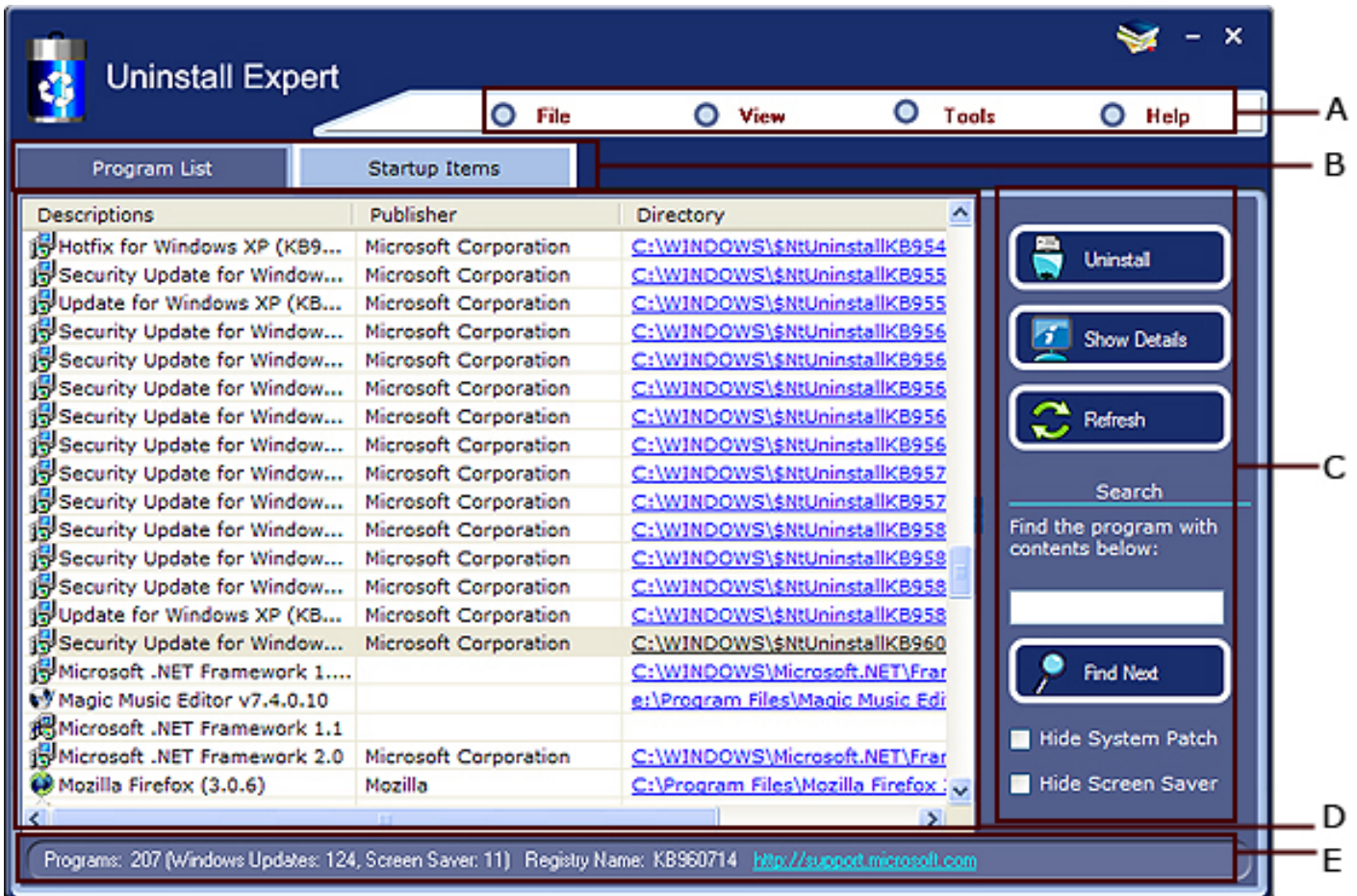

A: Menu Panel: Includes tabs for "File", "View", "Tools", and "Help".

B: Flexible GUI: Two interfaces can be selected as "Program List" or "Startup Items".

C: Quick Shortcuts Panel: Shortcuts to four functions of **Uninstall Expert** are displayed on the right side of the page.

Uninstall: Uninstalls selected programs.

Show Details: Displays details of selected program (including Program Properties and Registry Values).

Refresh: Refreshes the current information of the program.

Find Next: Searches for a specific installed application.

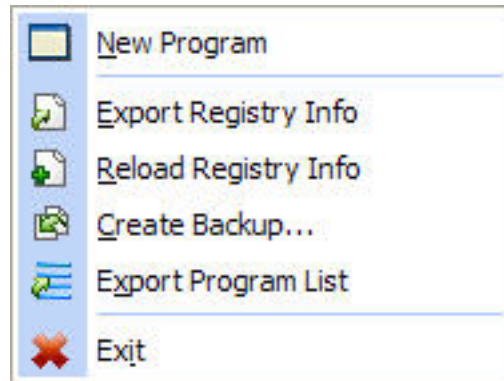
Hide the system patch and Hide the screen saver by checking the corresponding boxes.

D: Main Area: Displays the installed programs as well as some detail information.

E: State Bar: Show selected program's detailed information.



File Menu



New Program

Add a new program onto your computer at will.
The following steps describe how to add a new program:

Step 1: Click "New Program" to open the Windows Run dialog.

Step 2: Type the name of a program or click "Browse" to select the setup file. Click "OK" and windows will open it for you.

Registry Information

A: After pitching on a program, users can click "Export Registry Info" on the menu bar to export the registry information, or just right-click the pitched program to click the popup "Export Registry Info".

B: Clicking "Reload Registry Info" to reload registry files into the selected program.

C: Backup the registry information of all installed software by clicking "Create Backup".

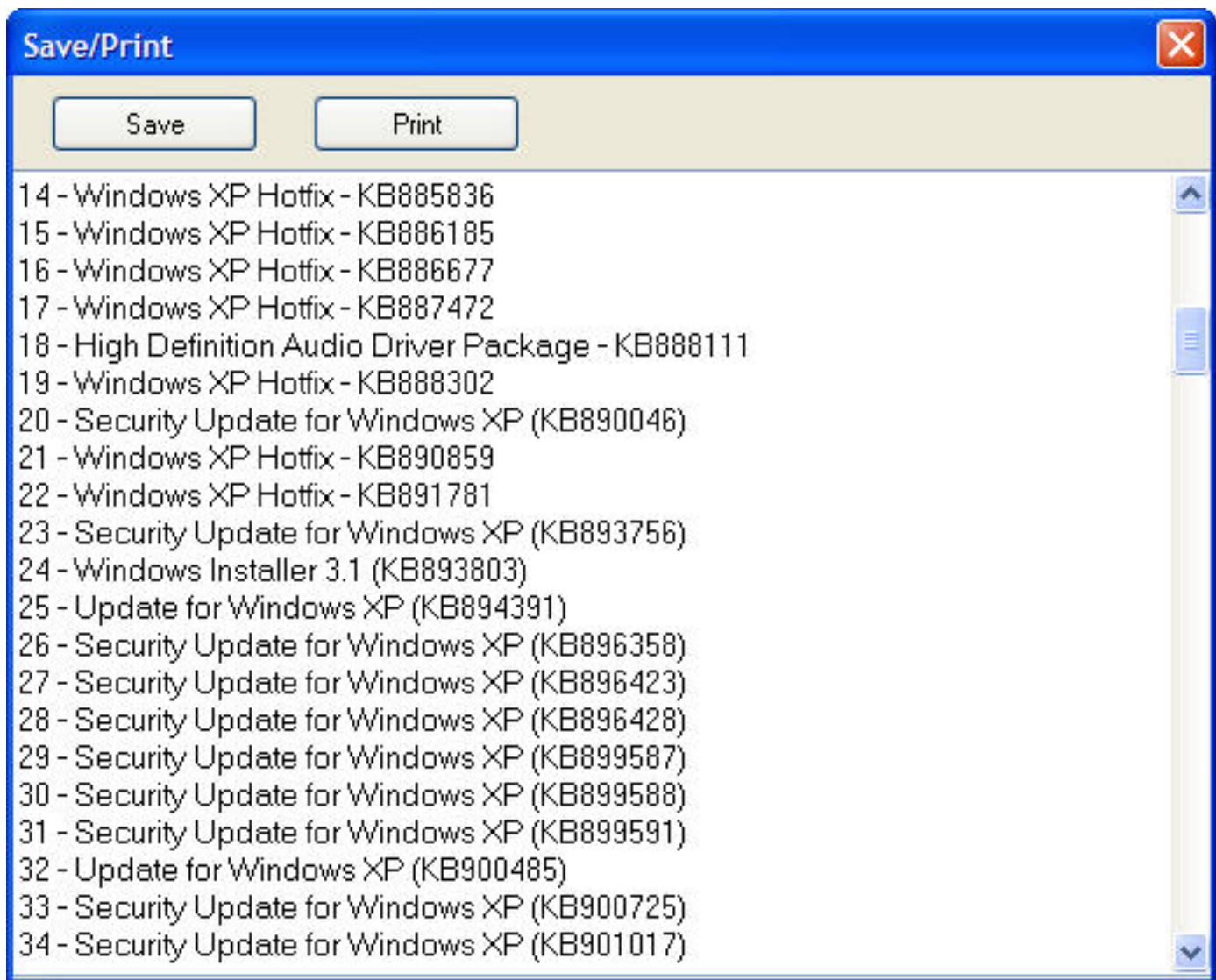
The back up registry information of all installed programs will be automatically saved as installed folder\Back up\reg.

A deleted screen saver can be recovered from installed folder\back up*.scr; and saved to C:\Windows\System32\dlldata.

Export Program List

Select the "Export Program List" and the following dialog will be popped-up:

Create a full report for the installed programs and save the report to a text file or print (installed printer required).

Change View Style

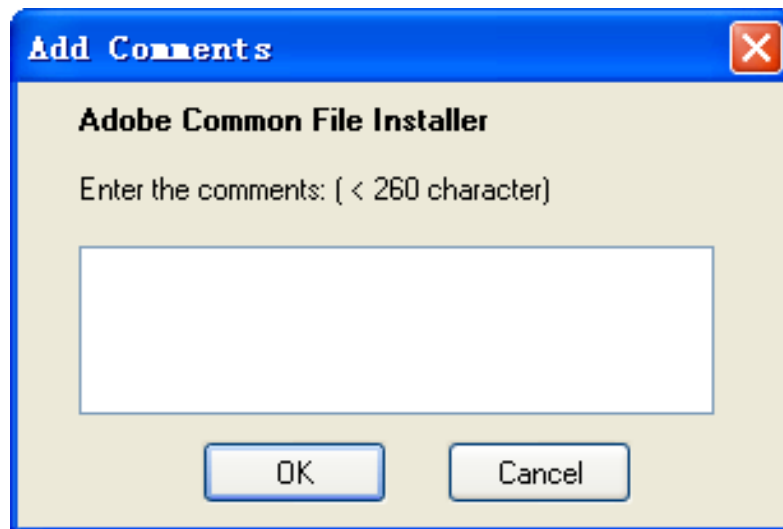
Users can just click "View" to change viewing style.

Tool Part

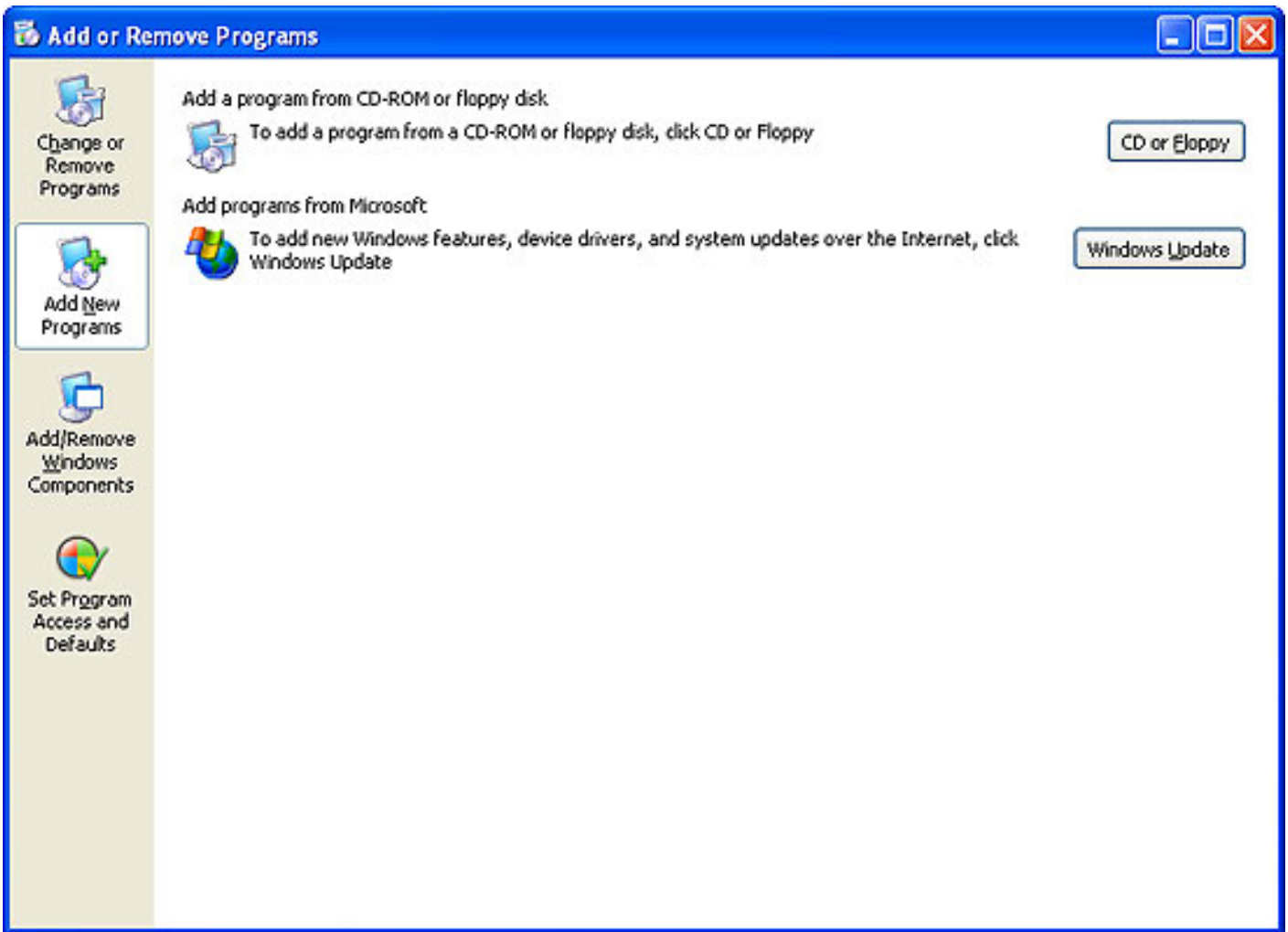
Click Tools to perform the following actions:

Users can add comments for a selected program in the registry by clicking "Comment Entry". Click "OK" to save and "Cancel" to cancel.

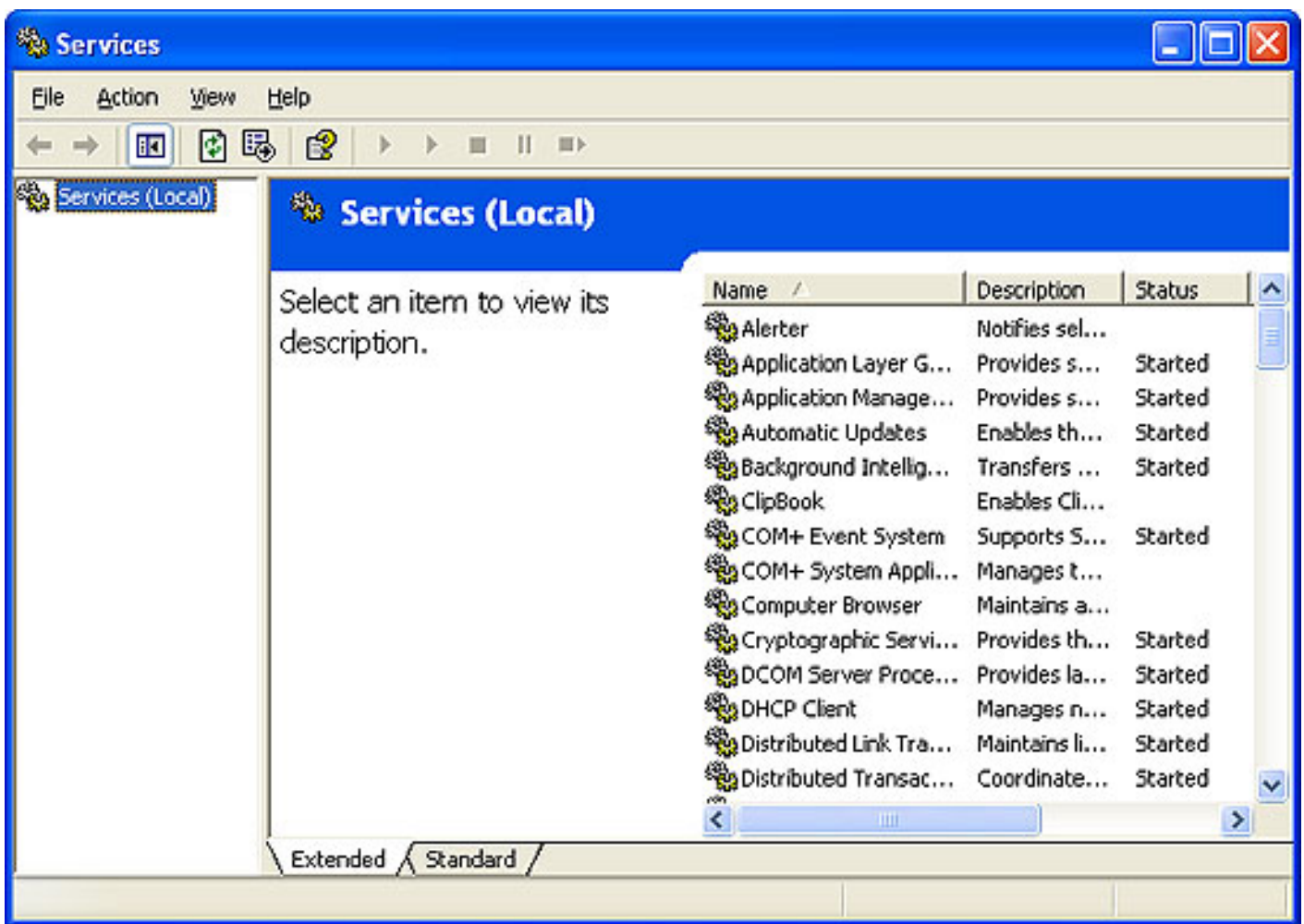


Click "Registry Editor" to edit the registry information. A REGEDIT box will appear for editing.

Select "Windows Update" to update windows settings, add new programs, add new windows features or update windows system.



Select "Windows Services" to view service details. Suspend, pause or start up selected services.



At "Windows Components" part, users can add or remove components of Window by checking the corresponding checkbox.

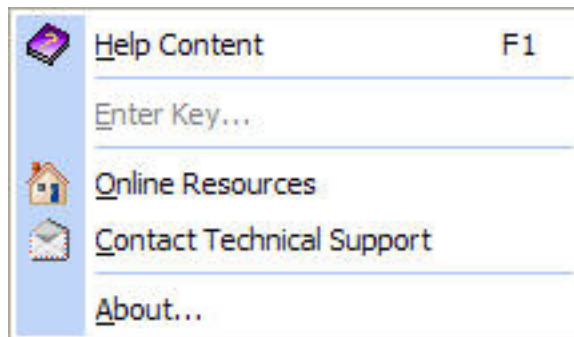

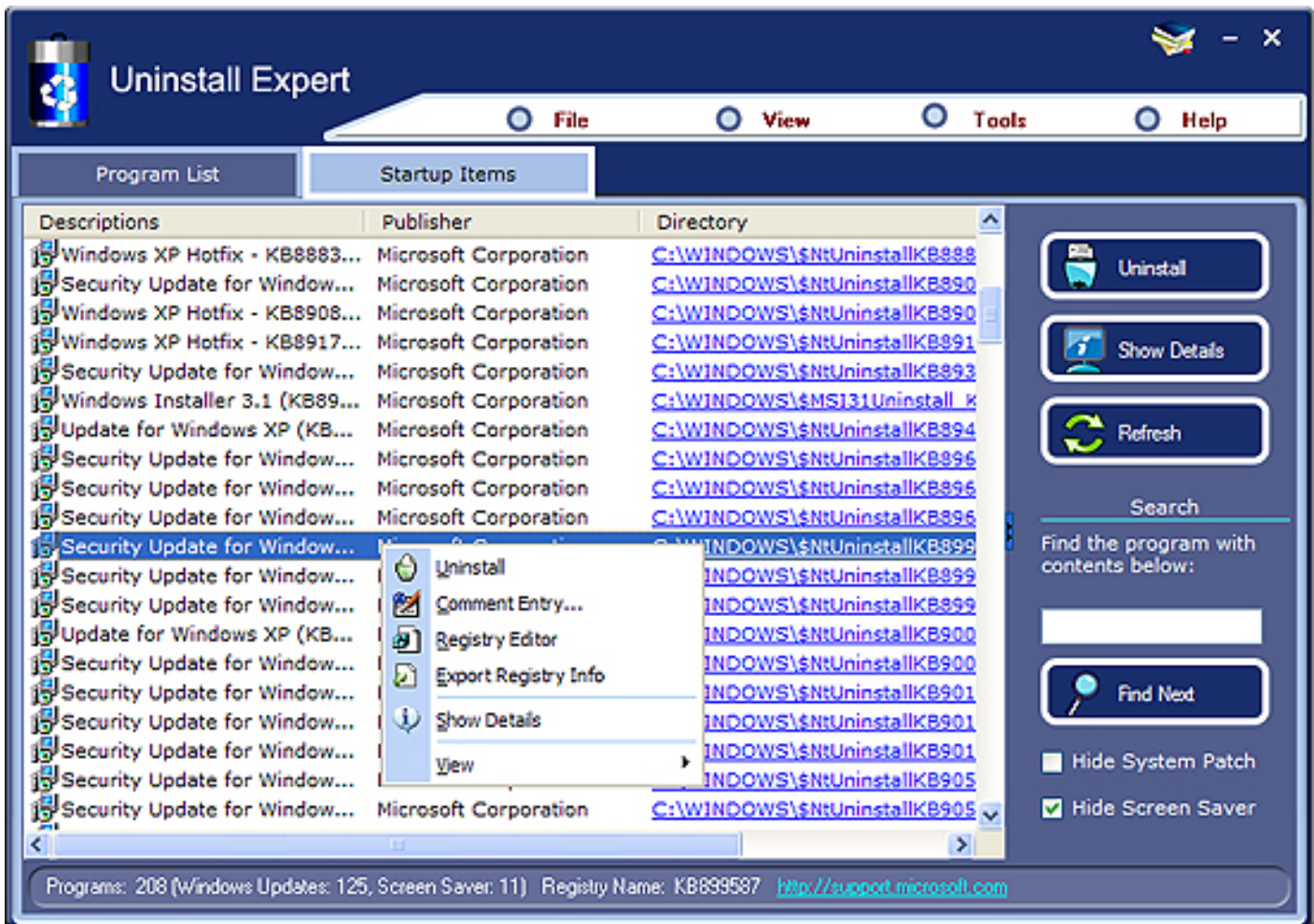

Programs list

The following steps can help users to uninstall application by using those buttons on the interface:

Right click a program, you will see a menu like this:



Uninstall: Right click a program, and then click **Uninstall** to uninstall the program as well as its files, folders completely.

Comment Entry: Guides you to add comments for the selected program.

Registry Editor: Guides you to edit the registry information.

Export Registry Info: Export the registry information of selected program.

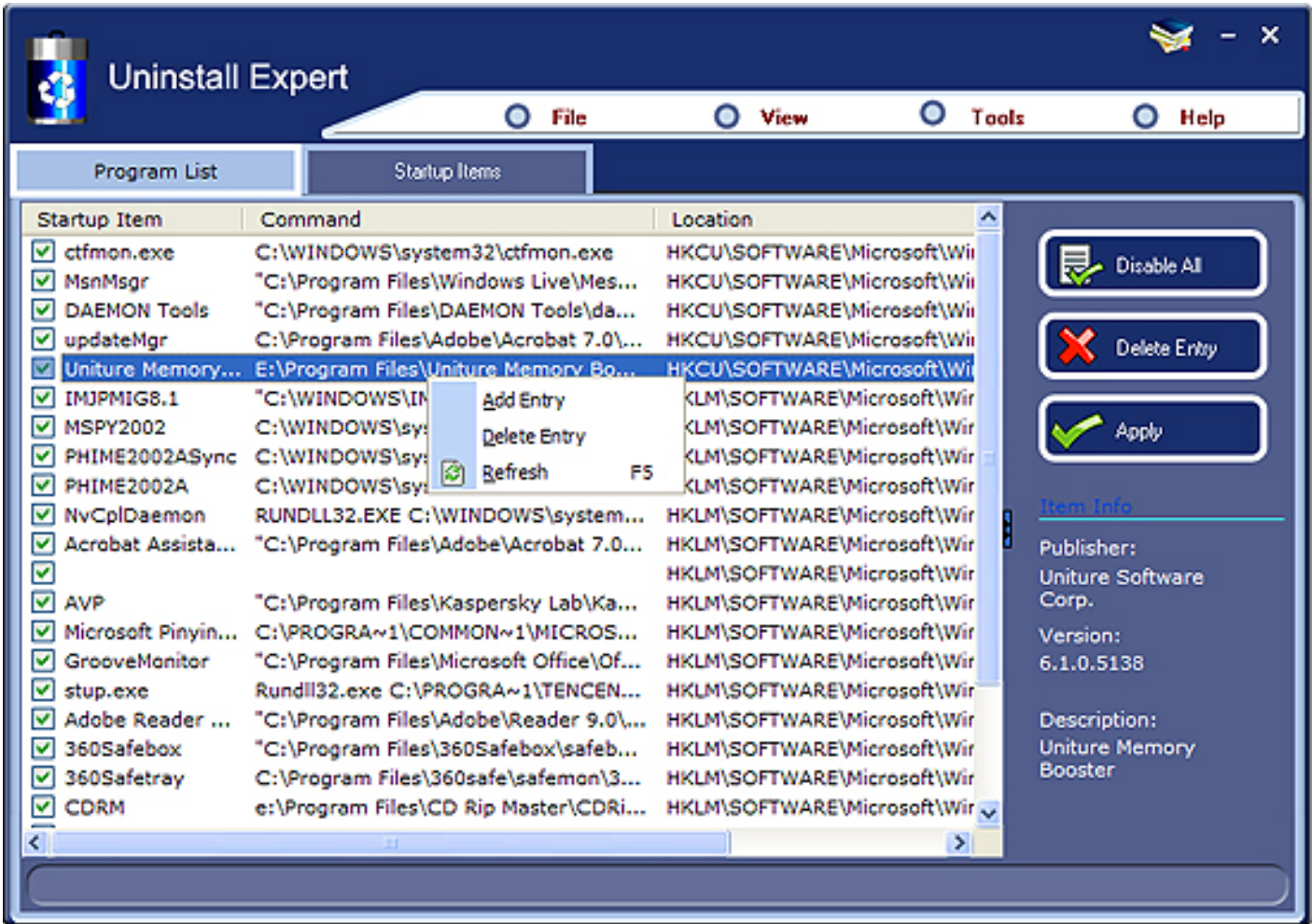
Show details: Show details of selected program, including Program Properties and Registry Values. It also allows you to see program information easily.

View: Display programs in different ways (Icons, List and Details).

You can open the folder of the program when you click the hyperlink listed in directory.



Startup Item

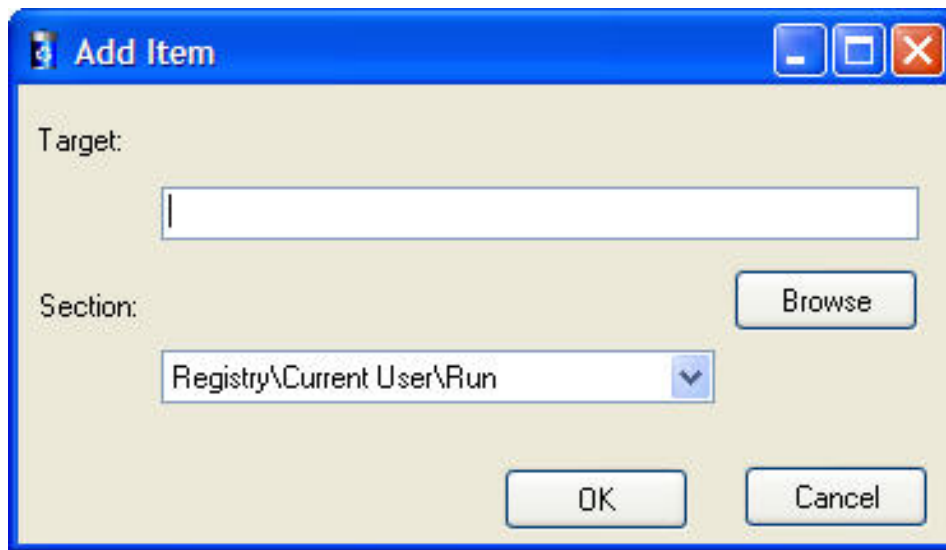


All the programs showed in the "Startup Items" are run automatically when starting computer. Users can make the desired program automatically run or stop when starting computer.

The following functions can help users to get familiar with the interface:

Add Entry

1. Right-click the selected program, click Add Entry in the task box and an "Add Item" dialog will appear:



2. Type the target name or click "Browse" to select the program you want to add. Select one of four different ways for windows to start up the selected program:

- A: Startup Folder\Current User: Allows selected program to automatically run at startup of a specific user.
- B: Startup Folder\All User: Allows selected program to automatically run at startup of any user.
- C: Registry\Current User\Run: Add a key under HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Run, then it will run as windows startup.
- D: Registry\All User\Run: Add a key under HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\Software\Microsoft\Windows\CurrentVersion\Run, then it will run as windows startup.

3: Click "OK" to confirm settings or "Cancel" to delete settings.

Disable All

Disable all items to automatically run at computer startup by clicking "Disable All".

Enable all items to run automatically at computer startup by clicking "Enable All".

Delete Entry

Delete an unnecessary item from the list by clicking "Delete Entry".

Apply the settings

Save all changes by clicking Apply.

Item information

Select a item to view the item information including the publisher, version and description.



Uninstall Programs:

There are two ways to uninstall program. Users can choose any one as you like.

The First One:

1. Click on a desired program to uninstall at "Program List" window.
2. Click "Uninstall" at the right side panel.
3. A window will pop-up to confirm your operation, click "Yes" to continue the next step, or "No" to cancel uninstall operation.
4. The next pop-up window will prompt you to remove the rest unneeded registry keys or files, then click "Yes" to continue uninstalling or "No" to leave the rest things.
5. A scan dialog will appear to show you the remaining files, click "Delete" to finish uninstalling or "Cancel" to leave it as it is.

The Second One:

1. Right-click the desired program at "Program List" window.
2. A pop-up window will show up.
3. Click "Uninstall" at the pop-up window.
4. A window will pop-up to confirm your operation, click "Yes" to continue the next step, or "No" to cancel uninstall operation.
5. The next pop-up window will prompt you to remove the rest unneeded registry keys or files, then click "Yes" to continue uninstalling or "No" to leave the rest things.
6. A scan dialog will appear to show you the remaining files, click "Delete" to finish uninstalling or "Cancel" to leave it as it is.

FAQs

Q: How to disable/enable an application from auto start?

A: You only have to remove the check mark in front the application you want to disable from Startup Item when Windows starts. And conversely to enable it put a check and it is enabled.

Q: How to uninstall an application with Uninstall Expert?

A: In Uninstaller there are two ways. Select the application in the list and press "Uninstall" button in the quick shortcut panel on the left, double click or press right mouse button over the application in the list and select "Uninstall" command.

Q: How to search the installed application?

A: On the left of main area, there is a quick shortcut panel, you just type the program name you want to search, and then click the Find Next button.

Q: How to change View type?

A: From the uninstaller toolbar you can change the view of the list of applications. You have to use drop down button and click on the little arrow on its right side, which will show you the menu with all list view options - Icon, List and Report. Other faster and simple way to change that view is by just clicking on the View button.

Q: How to backup the registry information of the installed program?

A: Enter the File menu, just click the Create Backup, then it will backup your registry information of the installed program automatically.

Q: How to enter the location of installed program?

A: In the program list, there is the directory of the program, just click the hyperlink, and then it will open the folders.

Q: How to export the programs list?

A: Enter the File menu, drop down to the Export Programs List, click it, then you can save and print the program list.
